Veteran Dog/Bitch (3, 0a)

1. Holt's Plaiglen Beaters Bejewel to Bethryn JW. 7yr old L&W bitch with lovely side profile and moderate angles throughout. Feminine head with enough work, nicely arched neck and level topline. Standing on good bone and feet. Moved well with drive. BV
2. Richardson and Terry-Richardson's Cherishym Chara. 9yr old L&W bitch, an honest type with a kind dark eye and expression. Good side profile, level topline, enough bone and nicely angulated. Less positive than usual on the move today.
3. Happs Clentonian Solomon Seal.

Minor Puppy Dog (2, 2a)

Puppy Dog (2, 0a)

1. Calvert's Calvdale Ever Thus. Smart masculine young boy with plenty of substance and mature for age. Nice profile on the stand with deep chest, tight elbows, well ribbed for age. Shown in excellent coat and condition. Really enjoying himself and moved well once he settled. BPD, BPIS.
2. Reynold's Clentonian Pitch Perfect. A little out of proportion at the moment, more rangy and less mature than 1, currently up on leg. Good reach of neck, level topline, standing on good bone and feet. Well presented in good coat and condition. Happy on the move with time on his side to mature.

Junior Dog (2, 1a)

1. Calvert's Scaramouche Jones. 1yr old mature youngster with masculine well-proportioned head with dark eye and kind expression. Plenty of substance and bone, deep chest, well bodied standing on neat feet. Well coated in excellent condition. Smart side profile and moved well once settled.

Yearling Dog (2,0a)

1. Topliss' Beresford Lockdown 19 month old quality boy who drew my eye as he entered the ring. Lovely balanced outline on the stand, masculine head with enough work with kind eye and expression. Moderately angled throughout with good reach of neck, correct shoulder placement, deep chest, enough body and rib, standing on good bone and feet. Showed himself off on the move, covering the ground with reach and drive, BD.
2. Jenkinson's Eastriding Royal Black. 22 month old smart B&W boy. Rangier than 1 and less mature overall however retains quality. Lovely dark eye, good body and rib, moderate angulation, enough bone and neat feet. Nice side profile with level topline which he held on the move. Shown in excellent coat and condition.

Graduate Dog (0)

Post-Graduate Dog (3, 2a)

1. Richardson and Terry-Richardson's Cherishym Dofida. Smart compact young B&W dog in excellent coat and condition however not on his best behaviour today. Masculine head with enough work and dark eye and kind expression. Enough bone and substance, moderately angled and proportioned with enough rib and body. Moved OK but made it hard for his handler.

Limit Dog (4, 2a)

1. Richardson and Terry-Richardson's Cherishym Draconis. Another making life difficult for his handler today. L&W with masculine head, would prefer eyes a little darker. Similar attributes to his litter brother above, just slightly less compact.
2. Happs Clentonian Soloman Seal. Veteran dog, of larger stature than 1. Masculine throughout, with plenty of bone and substance, level topline, good spring of rib, in good coat and condition, moved well belying his age.

Open Dog (1, 0a)

1. Topliss' Sh Ch Beresford As Good As It Gets. Quality L&W male, masculine but not overdone. Lovely kind eye and expression, well-proportioned body, moderate angulation with balance throughout. Lovely profile on the stand and maintained his balance and topline on the move covering the ground with reach and drive. Well presented in excellent coat and condition. RBD.

Minor Puppy Bitch (1, 1a)

Puppy Bitch (2, 1a)

1. Reynold's Clentonian Picturesque. Pretty 9 month old feminine puppy, lacking maturity but has promising attributes that should develop well with time. Feminine head with kind dark eye, good reach of neck and level topline. Has enough bone and stands on neat feet. Settled on the move well.

Junior Bitch (2, 1a)

1. Calvert's Calvdale Flutter. Just loved this young LW&T bitch who oozes quality. Mature for age and balanced throughout. Lovely feminine head with enough work. Eyes dark enough with kind alert expression. Good reach of neck, correct shoulder placement and level topline. Moderately angled throughout with enough bone, looked smart on the stand with good depth of chest, enough rib and body and kept her balance when moving around the ring with drive. RBB and RBIS.

Yearling Bitch (3, 0a)

1. Topliss' Sandylands Send My Love. L&W up to size but retains femininity. Attractive side profile, deep chest, level topline, well ribbed in good coat and condition. Enough bone and good feet. Moved well.
2. McCourt's Meadowdale Solitaire at Woodspa. L&W of nice size and shape. Feminine head, good reach of neck with level topline, moderate angulation and enough bone and substance. Moved well.
3. Rose's Plaiglen Raggtrade

Graduate Bitch (1, 0a)

1. Rose's Plaiglen Raggtrade. Feminine throughout, alert kind expression with dark eye. Standing on enough bone and neat feet. Good spring of rib, level topline. Shown in good coat and condition. Moved OK.

Post Graduate Bitch (3,1a)

1. Holt's Bethryn Sea of Tranquility. L&W with attractive profile. Feminine head with kind eye and expression, enough bone and substance. Well ribbed with enough chest and in good condition. Enjoying her day and moved well when settled.
2. Wiley's Speeton Sea Grace. Nice type with balanced head and lovely dark eye. Enough neck and level topline. Well ribbed with enough bone and substance. Stood well however was little anxious on the move today.

Limit Bitch (4,1a)

1. Smith's Molverly Ravello. Attractive bitch with a feminine head and dark eye, nicely arched neck with balanced outline and shape. Enough depth and rib. Shown in excellent coat and condition. Moved well with reach and drive.
2. Jenkins Eastriding Glam Princess. Pretty L&W bitch, feminine throughout in excellent coat and condition. Good lay of shoulder, level topline with enough bone and neat feet. Lacked a little positivity on the move today.
3. Hipgrave's Ternspringer Jazz Singer

Open Bitch (4,1a)

1. Wildsmith and Brown's Sh Ch Trimere Tickle Me Fancy. Wow, what a beautiful bitch in her prime. Presents a lovely outline both standing and moving and I have never seen her look better. Such a pretty well made head with a melting expression, slightly arched neck with well laid shoulders and level topline. Good spring of rib and deep enough chest. Standing on good bone and neat feet. Feminine, moderate and balanced throughout both standing and on the move. Presented to perfection in excellent coat and condition and at one with her handler. Owned the ring moving with reach and drive. BB, BIS.
2. Smith's Melverley L'il Dancer. Another lovely bitch shown in great coat and condition. Heavier in build than 1 but retains femininity with a pleasing outline. Good depth of chest and well ribbed. Well off for bone and nicely angulated. Moved well.
3. Hancock's Sh Ch Meadowdale Jedi of Hanknight. Best B&W.
