VD (2) 1. Lewis and Bullocks' Trixhund Talking Obsession JW ShCM ShCEX VW. Pleasing head with a lovely expression, good reach of neck, adequate depth of chest and a good straight front, correct shoulder angles, level topline and moderate rear, movement was true but lacking that extra drive from the rear.

2. Murdoch's Roqfolly Spectre. Nice head, straight front and good lay of shoulder, but not so steady on the stack today, shorter in body length than 1 and moved a little close on rear.

MPD (3) 1. Chandler's Elazlan Tribal Craft. Nice balanced outline at this age, pleasing head with that melting puppy expression, straight front, good reach of neck and adequate depth of chest, both front assembly and rear angles of correct proportions and moved OK for age BP.

2. Le-Clerc's Hunterheck Fade To Black. Taller and finer than 1 but none the less all the correct attributes and moved OK.

3. West's Allenies Rhythm Of The Night.

PGD (3,1) 1. Topliss' Sandylands Stand N Deliver Nice head, straight front, well laid shoulders, level topline, well muscled quarters and moved OK.

2. Morgans' Dexbenella Frilled To Bitz. On first glance a very balanced outline and looked to be well constructed but reluctant for me to go over him in order to assess correctly.

OD (3) 1. Allen and Bott's Sh Ch Trimere Tipping Point Of Allenie. Quality dog presenting a very balanced outline, well constructed head with good eye and kind expression, well boned straight forelegs, well shaped feet, excellent shoulder assembly, deep chest and well sprung ribs, strong topline and loin leading to muscular thighs with nicely bent stifles, a joy to watch as he covered the ground with ease, true front and rear with reach in front and strong drive from rear DCC, BOB and pleased to see him awarded a very well deserved G4.

2. Calvert's Calvdale Scaramouche Jones. Very close up and many of the above comments apply but just not quite as strong a topline on the move as 1 but he still showed good front movement with feet well forward and driving rear from strong hocks. Unlucky to meet 1 on such form. RCC.

3. Topliss's Sh Ch Beresford Lockdown.

VB (1) 1. Weyman's Spuffing Molly's Secret. This 7 year old stood alone but deserved the place, Nice head with pleasing expression, straight forelegs, adequate layback of shoulder, level topline, good quarters and moved true but needs to use her tail on the move to complete the picture.

MPB (2) 1. Savell's Petranella Tipping The Wink. Nicely balanced throughout with pleasing head and all the correct angles, level topline and moved OK.

2. Le Clerc's Hunterheck Lost In A Spell. Another nicely constructed youngster with all the essentials but not giving of her best today both standing or on the move. Would benefit from further ringcraft training.

JB (1). 1. Weyman's Spuffing Prosecco. Nice outline with pleasing head and expression, Good reach of neck, correct shoulders, level topline, good quarters and moved well but needs coat to complete the picture.

PGB (2) Close decision as both well constructed and presented an attractive outline. 1. Corbett's Trimere Time Fls. Typical feminine head with kind eye and expression, straight and well boned front legs, good shoulder placement, level topline, well angled rear and moved well.

2. Keely's Alhambian Amy Winehouse. Another of good breed type and well constructed throughout but not so steady as 1 on the move today.

LB (2) 1. Calvert's Calvdale Flutter JW. Very balanced in outline with nothing overdone, well balanced head with expressive dark eye, forelegs straight, well boned with tight feet, good depth of chest, correct layback of shoulders, compact, level topline, correct body proportions overall, muscular loin, well set tail and strong correctly angled quarters, moved so well covering the ground with drive from the rear and reach in front clearly enjoying her day. CC.

2. Topliss' Sandylands Send My Love. Close up with some similar attributes but not so strong on topline and low tail carriage on the move where she did move true both front and rear.

OB (4) 1. Cokell's Carlyquinn Kisses Of Fire. Easy winner showing good breed type, well proportioned head with kind expression, straight front, well laid shoulders, well sprung ribs, level topline, strong loin, good rear angles and moved in true breed fashion with animation RCC.

2. Topliss' Sh Ch Beresford Night Class. Close up and above comments apply, but did not give of her best today on the move.
