MPD (2,1) 1. Weyman's More Than Amazing Wanna Be A Gangster at Spuffing. 8 months liver and tan, very good head and eye, well constructed with excellent bone and body for his age, very good flow over neck and shoulders, excellent front, bone and feet, good depth and width of chest, strong top-line and good tail set, strong well muscled and angulated hindquarters, sound mover, showed well.

PD 2(1) 1. Merry's Gleadbury It Is Destiny for Anacapa. Liver/white with a good head, well constructed with a very pleasing outline, strong top-line and good tail set, good front, bone and feet, excellent body properties and strong short coupled loin, strong well angulated hindquarters, sound mover, shown in very good coat and condition, BP.

JD 2(1) 1. Eyeington's Meadowdale Twix. Liver/white, masculine head, pleasing eye and expression, handsome dog with a good outline, strong top-line and good tail set, good front assembly, very good shoulder placement and good body properties, in good coat and show condition, moved soundly.

PGD 4(2) 1. Such's Carlquinn Captain Ross at Mujascal JW. Liver/white, very good head and eye, upstanding with a good outline, excellent front, bone and feet, very good front assembly, strong well angulated hindquarters, strong top-line and good tail set, in good coat, sound positive mover with a good tail action.
2. Warrener's Eastfalla Sherlock Holmes. Black/white from a smaller mould, pleasing head and good eye, not the forehand of the winner, good front, bone and feet, strong top-line, sound mover.

LD 2(0) 1. Topliss' Sandylands Stand N Deliver. Liver/white, very good head and eye, excellent front assembly with good bone and feet, strong crested neck with lovely flow over shoulders, very well balanced and constructed, well knit together with excellent body properties, strong loin and strong well angulated hindquarters, lovely outline with a strong top-line both standing and moving, very sound mover with super carriage, in excellent coat and bloom, DCC & BOB.
2. Morgans' Dexbenella Frilled to Bitz. Excellent head and eye, very good breed type, well constructed and balanced throughout, strong top-line and good tail set, very good front, bone and feet, well muscled hindquarters, moved soundly and showed well, in good coat.

OD 4(1) 1. Calvert's Calvdale Ever Thus JW. Liver/white, very good head and eye, excellent balance and construction throughout, very good front, bone and feet, good height and reach at the front, strong top-line and good tail set, strong short coupled loin, in good coat and show condition, moved soundly and showed well, RDCC.
2. Topliss' Sh Ch. Beresford Night Train. Excellent head and eye with very pleasing breed type, well balanced and constructed with very good front assembly, strong top-line and good tail set, short coupled loin and well angulated hindquarters, sound active mover, not quite the body properties of winner.
3. Eyeington's Sh Ch. Meadowdale Daisydale Lightning Bolt.

GCDS 1(0) 1. Warrener's Eastfalla Sherlock Holmes. Repeat.

VB 1(0) 1. Joyce's Kingsheath Total Diva at Felltops. 7 years, lovely head and eye, very good breed type, upstanding with a very good outline, well balanced and constructed throughout, strong top-line and good tail set, very good front, bone and feet, short coupled loin, strong well angulated hindquarters and good body properties, in good coat and condition, sound mover.

MPB 1(0) 1. Calvert's Calvdale Dramatic Effect. 8 months, very pretty head and good eye, a lovely outline, well balanced and constructed, excellent shoulder placement, super front, bone and feet, very good forehand, strong top-line and good tail set, excellent body properties, strong short coupled loin, sound positive mover, showed well, she gave so much away in age and maturity to the dog puppy but I know we will see a lot more of this lovely bitch.

PB 2(0) 1. House's Gleadbury Destiny Belle. Very pleasing head, 11 months with good body properties, front, bone and feet, strong top-line and good tail set, short coupled loin and well angulated hindquarters, moved soundly.

2. Tolladay's Calvdale Half A Story Bethersden. Black/white from a larger mould, upstanding with a good forehead, pleasing head and eye, good bone and feet, would like more width of chest, strong top-line and good tail set, needs time to develop, sound mover.

JB 2(1) 1. Smith's Sh Ch. Melverly Iridescent. Liver/tan/white, beautiful head, lovely eye and expression, very well balanced and constructed throughout, lovely breed type, excellent front, bone and feet, good depth and width of chest, super body with a lovely outline, strong top-line and good tail set, strong short coupled loin, strong well angulated hindquarters, in excellent coat and show condition, sound and positive movement in her class but was very erratic in the challenge.

PGB 6(2) 1. Ainsley/Nicklin/Henderson's Daenerys Red Priestess. Lovely head and eye, well constructed throughout, good front, bone and feet, lovely outline, strong top-line and good tail set, strong, short coupled loin, well angulated hindquarters, very well knit together throughout, moved very well holding her top-line at all times.

2. Savell's Petranella Tipping The Wink JW. Very pleasing head and eye, again well constructed and balanced, good front, bone and feet, presented a very good outline when standing, sound positive mover with strong well angulated hindquarters.

3. Joyce's Peasblossom Aura at Felltops.

LB 3(0) 1. Corbett's Trimere Turn Back Time. Liver/tan/white, lovely head and eye, very good front, bone and feet, good depth and width of chest, strong top-line and good tail set, lovely outline, strong loin, very well balanced throughout, sound steady mover holding her top-line very well, in lovely coat and bloom.

2. Topliss' Sandylands Send My Love. Mature upstanding bitch, well constructed with a very good outline, excellent body properties, pleasing head, not quite the expressive eye of the winner and slightly longer cast, strong well angulated hindquarters, in very good coat and condition, a very exuberant mover.

3. Williams/Toublic's Cobhay Fancy Phlox.

OB 5(0) 1. Corbett's Sh Ch. Trimere Time Flvs. Lovely head and eye, displayed very good breed type, upstanding with a mature body, excellent balance and construction throughout, lovely outline, excellent front, bone and feet, I loved her height and reach, strong top-line which she held at all times and a good tail set, short coupled loin and strong well angulated hindquarters, in excellent coat and condition, sound positive mover fore and aft, BCC.

2. Calvert's Sh Ch. Calvdale Flutter JW. Liver/tan/white, beautiful head and eye, lovely breed type, excellent front, bone and feet, balanced and well constructed, very feminine but has body, bone and substance, strong short coupled loin and strong hindquarters, sound positive mover in lovely coat, RBCC, a super class.

3. Casey/Jayes' Sh Ch. Sandylands Send The Roses.

GCDSB 1(0) 1. Williams/Toublic's Cobhay Fancy Phlox. Pleasing head and eye, mature bitch with good breed type, good bone and feet, good front assembly, would like a little more height at the front, strong top-line, good spring of rib, short coupled loin, strong well angulated hindquarters, moved soundly.
