1st Davis's Madisaromar Big Apple – 7yrs LWT, lovely strong masculine head, eager to please expression, good eye colour and shape, in excellent hard condition, strong neck of good length, nicely placed shoulders enabling to reach out freely, strong hind quarters good depth to body, straight front, good topline tight feet, strong limbs, presented to perfection, just lacked drive today. 1st Casey & Jayes Sandylands Xpress Delivery - L&W 9mth, wow, what a stunner, very appealing head of correct proportions, he has that mischievous expression you expect from a youngster, his neck is adequate in length, leading down to well placed shoulders, strong straight front, standing on solid well boned limbs and tight feet, he carries ample spring of rib, in lovely hard condition for one so young, he moved out so freely with great reach and drive. 1st Richardson & Terry Richardson's Cherishym Dofida – A very smart B/W of 17mths, lovely head of equal proportions, a soft melting expression with correct shaped dark eyes, awaited me, when stood he presents a lovely balanced shape that just flows, he has super spring of ribs, straight strong limbs, tight feet, and well let down hocks, when settled he moved with such drive, from broad well muscled thighs, I considered him for the RDCC, surly a star of the future. Well presented.

2nd Jenkinson's Eastriding Royal Black – 14mths, a smart male, just not as mature looking as 1st, but he has time on his side, he presented a biddable expression that drew me in, his head piece is of good proportion, shoulder placement is good, another standing on strong straight limbs, at this time not quite the depth of 1st, but saying that he carries a good spring of rib, strong broad thighs that enabled him to cover the ground in a free and happy movement.

1st Thomas's Tigerrock Ocellatus – 2yr old BWT – He presents a dark picture when stood, due to his very dark markings, but saying that he carries a nice head, with an honest eager to please expression, he has good muscle tone and plenty of heart room, he stands on tight feet, just not settled on the move today, but when he moved he moved with exuberance.

1st Rowlinson's Meltarose Midshipman – 19mth LWT, a smart very handsome male, surely with a very bright future, he holds a lovely head piece, kind expression and lovely dark eye colour, ample strength & length in neck, heading to a good lay of shoulder, he stands on straight well boned limbs and tight feet, he has a straight front with good depth to chest and body, he is in hard condition which showed as he used his strength on the move, presented to perfection, another I considered for RDCC.

2nd Morgans Dexbenella Frilled to Bitz – 2yr old L&W of a different shape to 1st, nice head would like a darker eye, he stands on well boned limbs and tight feet, he has enough heart room, good broad thighs that are well toned, moved well, good presentation.

3rd Richardson & Terry-Richardson's Cherishym Draconis – 17mth L&W, a bit of a handful for his handler today, stood he presents a lovely balanced shape, appealing head, dark eyes, with a glint of mischief, he is well toned, with well let down hocks, just needs to settle a bit on the move, but that said I liked him a lot,

1st Rowlinson's Meltarose Midshipman – 1st in Novice Dog,

2nd. Whitworth's Lordsett Jim Beam at Freworth (Imp Pol) – Good depth to body, strong well sprung ribs with plenty of heart room, he stands on good strong limbs and tight feet, strong well muscled thighs, just not coordinated on the move today, presented well.

3rd Thomas's Tigerrock Super Ted – 4yr very dark liver and white, he has the most appealing expression with the kindest eyes that you just want to hug, he is slightly longer cast than 1st & 2nd, but saying that, he was well toned, but I don't think he had his showing head on today.

1st Eyeington's Meadowdale Daisydale Lightning Bolt – 2yr old BWT, lovely throughout, he holds a strong masculine head, with a soft expression that draws you in, his eyes are dark and correct in shape, he is balanced throughout, he carries a strong well toned neck, of ample length leading to well placed shoulders, he also stands on well boned limbs and tight feet, he strong solid broad thighs that gave him that ground covering drive on the move, beautifully presented. RDCC.

LD. 5(2a)

1st Jenkinson's Eastriding Royal Mayfair JW – 3yr old L&W nothing over done on this well balanced boy, he carries a classical head, well proportioned in shape, super dark eyes, adequate neck length and strength, straight front with good width at chest, straight limbs, tight feet, enough depth of body, toned throughout, well made hindquarters which enabled him to move with ease, well presented.

2nd Osbourne's Pendarlow Peter Pan with Braego – 4yr old different shape and type to 1st, still a lot to like though, neck ok in length, he carries good depth to body, feet ok, he is well toned and on the move he did so with purpose and drive, He is just finer all through than 1st, presented in good condition.

3rd Morgan's Kennair Dreamin on a Star – 6yr old, well presented, stood he is masculine all through, his head is of suitable proportions with a lovely kind, biddable expression, his eyes are dark and honest, he is slightly longer cast in body than 1st & 2nd, that said he has ample spring of rib, strong thighs and well toned throughout, he moved free and easy.

OD. 5(2a)

1st Topliss's Sh Ch Beresford Night Train – 4yr old L&W a worthy champion, and one I have admired from a puppy, Wow, well balanced throughout nothing over done at all, he holds a traditional head of equal proportions, strong neck, correct lay of shoulder, super strong straight limbs, standing on tight feet, he has great heart room, and is well toned throughout, broad solid thighs that gave him the power to cover the ground so freely while on the move, super presentation. DCC & BOB.

2nd Eyeington's Sh Ch Meadowdale Storm Trooper – 4yr old B&W, slightly larger all over, but saying that he presents a well balanced picture stood and on the move, he has a head to die for, an expression that draws you in, he is strong throughout and in really hard condition, he stands straight on well boned limbs and tight feet, he has masses of depth to body, ample spring of rib, he covers the ground with ease and purpose, beautifully presented.

3rd Rose's Westaway Dream Angus of Rosannoch (Imp Nor) – 6yr old L&W, my disappointment of the day, this boy I have watched and liked, today I felt he didn't have his "A" game head on, and lacked that usual umph he has, saying that he has a lovely masculine head, kind expression, lovely dark eyes, his neck is correct in length that leads to well placed shoulders, his body holds enough depth and he is in such hard condition, stood he also presents a well balanced shape, he moves well covering the ground with a free and easy stride, presented to perfection.

VB. 3(1a)

1st Corbett's Sh Ch Trimere Teresa Green – 8yr old she presents a gorgeous balanced shape stood and moving, she has a feminine head and kind honest expression, she stands on strong limbs and tight feet, she is so well toned throughout, she moved out with purpose and drive both coming and going, well presented. BVB & BVIB.

2nd Richardson & Terry-Richardson's Cherishym Chara – 8yr old L&W, she holds such a feminine head and expression, she has enough depth of body and spring of rib, she also stands on strong limbs, she is well toned throughout, just not the movement of 1st. Well presented.

1st Conrad's Strathnaver Starstruck – 7mth old, lovely feminine head, her expression is a mixture of mischief and kindness, her eyes are dark in colour and of correct shape, she has a strong neck, good depth to body, and spring of rib, her limbs are adequate, she presents a balanced picture stood, she moved out so happily with lots of exuberance.

JB. 5(1a)

1st hill's Peasblossom Tupelo Honey with Teignvalley – 12mth BWT up to size, she carries a lovely headpiece, her front is straight with enough chest room, she is well off for bone, has well placed shoulders, and stands on good straight limbs, ample spring of rib, she is in good hard condition which showed as she strode out round the ring with ease, well presented.

2nd Calvert's Calvdale Hostage of Fortyne – 13mth s, she is ultra feminine throughout, presenting a super eye catching shape when stood, her expression is soft, honest and kind which jump out at you from lovely dark eyes, she holds a neck of correct length, neat front, enough bone and stands on gorgeous tight feet, she is correct in length of body, which only enhances her topline which is correct and held well both stood and on the move, she is well toned but today I think she was a little over wrought, presented to perfection.

3rd Jenkinson's Eastriding Flower Princess – 14mths, L&W a finer frame than 1st and 2nd, she has a feminine headpiece, correct eye colour and shape, good ribs, and body depth, she also held her topline both stood and on the move, she just needs time to settle, well presented.

4th McCourt's Meadowdale Solitaire at Woodspa.

1st Harris's Melverly Burano – 18mths L&W, lovely classical head with a soft expression, strong neck and well placed shoulders, her limbs straight and well boned, her feet are tight, she has plenty of depth to her chest, ample spring of rib, her overall shape shouts classical to me, she is so well toned, good strong broad thighs which aided her strong, free and true movement around the ring, super presentation.

2nd Ramshaw's Elazlan Paperback Writer – 19ths B&W, slightly finer throughout than 1st, her expression is soft and kind, she wears a good front, with enough chest room, she is so well presented, when stood she presents a lovely shape, her movement today was a little unsettled but this will come with time,

1st Taubman's Meltarose Madeleine at Meonstoke – 19mths L&W presented a lovely shape stood, she carries a well balanced feminine headpiece with an honest expression, she has good reach of neck, good shoulder placement and enough bone, she has ample heart room, strong topline, well developed hind quarters, moved out well, presented to perfection.

2nd Harris's Melverly Burano – 1st in SBB.

3rd Rowlinson's Meltarose Mystique – 19mths LWT, not as settled as 1st & 2nd, nothing over done with her, neck and shoulders ok, she is toned, she has enough depth of body, strong limbs, was presented well, she just decided not to settle today, I'm sure this will change,

GB. 3

1st Cokell's Carlyquinn Kisses of Fire JW – 2yr old L&W, Ultra feminine all through, she has a gorgeous head, with an eager to please expression, strong well developed neck, good front, plenty of depth to body, her straight limbs reach down to tight feet, she is in hard condition, she holds her topline both stood and on the move,, her hindquarters are strong which enabled her to move with style around the ring, well presented.

2nd Rowlinson's Meltarose Mystique – 3rd in NB.

3rd Lillie's Freeway fortune – 3yr old L&W, a different type to 1st, she carries a nice head with good eye colour and shape, neck is ok in length, she is toned throughout, not quite the depth of body as 1st, moved well.

PGB. 4(1a)

1st Chandler's Elazlan Right of Reply – 19mths B&W, so feminine from the tip of her nose to the tip of her tail, holding a headpiece and expression to die for, she has correct shape of eye and so dark in colour, nothing over done about her in anyway, she presents a lovely well balanced shape when stood, she oozes style, her neck is moderate in length but strong, she has well placed shoulders, great depth to body and chest, a straight front, she stands on straight well boned limbs with the tightest of feet, ribs well sprung, she is toned throughout, strong hindquarters which came into play as she moved around the ring covering the ground with ease, superb presentation. BCC (I believe her 3rd) & BOS.

2nd Lillies's Freeway Remembrance – 3yr old L&W, a different type to 1st, she has a pleasing head, dark eyes, and kind expression, when stood she presented a balanced shape, she has good limbs and feet, enough depth to body, moved out with purpose, well muscled.

3rd Wallis & Levene's Pendarlow Tiana – 4yr old LWT, very unsettled today, but that said, she is a pleasant bitch, strong in body, if a little longer cast than 1st and 2nd, she moved ok, once settled.

LB.6(1a)

1st Smith's Melverly Lil Dancer – 2yr old L&W, a pretty super feminine bitch presenting a well balanced shape, both stood and on the move, she has a picture perfect head, dark eyes, correct in shape, her neck is moderate in length, correct lay of shoulder, deep in body and chest, she stands on strong well boned limbs and tight feet, she sports excellent spring of ribs, she has good muscle tone, strong broad thighs, she moved with drive and purpose, well presented. RBCC.

2nd Wilson & Connor's Portrail Turns the Swag on for Pinereoch – 4yr old L&W, different type to 1st, she holds a classical head, dark eyes of good shape, she presents a traditional shape when stood, there is nothing overdone about this bitch, moderate in length of neck, well placed shoulders, allowing for a free and easy swing when on the move, another standing on strong limbs and tidy feet, excellent body tone, enough spring of rib, moved around the ring with purpose on an easy stride, lovely presentation.

3^{ed} Corbett's Trimere Taylor Swift – 3yr old LWT, finer throughout than 1st and 2nd, she has a pleasing head, good neck, slightly longer in body than 1st and 2nd, good muscle tone, ample heart room, moved out with drive, well presented.

1st Wildsmith & Brown's Trimere Tickle me Fancy – 5yr old L&W, I've admired her as she has matured, she is so feminine throughout, head is of correct proportions, her expression kind and honest, she has enough length of neck which is strong, well placed shoulders, deep in body and chest, well sprung ribs, she also stands on straight limbs, excellent muscle tone, strong hind quarters which she used to her advantage on the move, presented in tip top condition.

2nd Topliss's Sh Ch Beresford Night Class – 4yr old L&W, soft expression, good neck, strong well toned body, holds her topline both stood and on the move, her movement strong and ground covering, well presented.

3rd Calvert's Calvdale Stowaway Magic JW – 3yr old LWT, feminine head, expression melting, another with the tightest of feet, she presents a lovely shape, well muscled, neck strong and of moderate length, she excels in body, spring of rib and hind quarters, she was ust a little unsettled today.
