I was delighted to be invited to judge for the 'Southern' having had the pleasure of serving on the committee for many years and becoming an Honorary Vice President on my retirement. The show was very well organised, as usual, and I was efficiently supported at the judges table and in the ring. Biased I am, but the 'Southern' do put on a very good show and as usual the atmosphere in the hall was very pleasant. My entry was lower in numbers but I found quality in very good measure which included several younger exhibits, a very good omen for the future of the breed. The standard was excellent in many classes and I often found myself splitting hairs when making my placings. However, there were some classes where I struggled to find sufficient quality. Overall, I was very impressed with my principle winners and pleasantly surprised with the quality contingent of black and whites here today. On the downside movement was much to be desired on some exhibits.

1 LAST'S MULIVIESS JAZZY JEFF BDP 6 months and about as 'raw' as they come however I remember our first springer was just the same at this age and she ended up winning a CC. Very pleasing head, not overdone, good basic proportions, good angulation, neatly set elbows, nice tight feet. Moved correctly and gave him the benefit of the doubt over the puppy dog on his potential - ugly duckling/handsome swan, maybe?

PD (3)

Not much to separate the first two here. Chalk and cheese in type but both displaying good qualities and should have bright futures in the showring.

1 WHITTOCK'S KINGSHEATH WILLIAM REGAL Good body with depth and strength in loin. Good reach of neck into well placed shoulders. Good bone and feet. Elbows well set into body. To be picky, slightly unbalanced in head and a tad long cast at this stage but moved well

2 TAUBMAN'S MEONSTOKE HAWTHORN Mature and compact with plenty of body. Pleasing head and expression. Enough neck, good bone and in very good condition. Moved o.k.

3 COX'S KINGSHEATH BRODUS CLAY

1 WALKER'S DEXBENELLA SIRIUS BLACK Seriously good b/w. Very smart with striking outline. Lovely head and melting expression. Clean neck flowing into good shoulders and forechest. Good depth through body with good firm topline, strong loin and good tailset. Good hind angulation, lovely bone and feet. Moved well

2 CALVERT'S CALVDALE ZERO TO HERO Stylish boy, slightly longer cast than 1 nevertheless well proportioned and refined, nice head and eye, good depth of chest, correct angulation fore and aft, having adequate bone and good feet, all contributing in making a quality specimen.

- 1 CALVERTS CALVDALE ZERO TO HERO
2 WARRENER'S WATERSWARREN WILLY WONKA Liked his head, masculine & well defined, good reach of neck running through to a good topline. Nice straight front but would like to see a little more angulation in shoulder construction. Good hindquarters and rear angulation. Moves well.

- 1 WHITTOCK'S MERRYWATER MINSTREL AT KINGSHEATH With his very heavy b/w markings he is no eyecatcher but a lovely dog to go over. His head is gorgeous despite the dark markings, masculine, well balanced and an expression enhanced by a super dark eye. Good through neck and shoulders, Nice depth of chest and neatly set elbows. Good bone and angulation. Moves well.
2 STEVENSON'S GAOLACHCARA SOMHLTH SHCM This is a good honest male Springer. Not glamorous or flashy but soundly put together within a very good frame and moves well. A little out of coat but a very good dog.

1 MITCHELL'S PEASBLOSSOM JESTER L/W/T with nice head and pleasing expression although his skull falls away slightly at the back. Nice arch of neck and clean throat. Very good shoulder placement and adequate forechest. Good depth through chest, good rib and strong in loin. Nice width of hindquarters and neat hocks. Slightly overangulated at times, but I think that was more to do with the handler because there was no sign of that on the move which was excellent. RCC

2 GLENDINNING'S PLAIGLEN HUSTLE Another very good B/W. Compact with a solid four square stance. Fabulous head and expression. Really good through his shoulders. Good depth through chest. Well ribbed and good width through loin and hindquarters. Nice bone and fabulous tight feet. Moved well. BB&W

1 WALKER'S SH CH DEXBENELLA IT'S ABOUT TIME JW SHCM L/W/T just turned 4 years old and is the finished article. Mature with presence and style. Well proportioned head with excellent definition and a wonderful kind expression. Good width and depth of muzzle. Lovely arching of neck, blending into excellent shoulder construction. Good rib and depth of chest. Lovely tight elbow set. Firm topline, strong loin, powerful hindquarters and correct tailset. Very good bone & feet. Moved soundly and with style to complete an excellent package. CC & BIS.

VD (3, 2 ABS)

1 GRAY'S TRIMERE TOP SCORE SHCM Looking very well for his 7 years and what a lovely type. Very good overall conformation and condition set off by a nice masculine head with super kind expression. BV

PRESIDENT SPECIAL OPEN STAKES DOG (2)

1 WALLIS' TORBECK PENRHYN BAYWorthy 3rd place in graduate class. Good conformation and pleasant outline, would like a little more neck and was a tad soft in pastern, nevertheless moved well and very well handled by his young owner.

2 PARR'S TIVERSTONE WOLF RIVER AT ASHRING Cobby type but lacked angulation and a little strong in head.

1 CALVERT'S CALVDALE DULY NOTED First time out at just 6months and two days. I am in no doubt that this lovely puppy is one that will be 'duly noted' many times in the future. She oozes quality with excellent conformation. Delightful head and correct eye shape, beautiful neck and shoulders. Good straight front with nice

bone and tight feet. Lovely forechest with good firm topline, nice body and depth through loin. Very good angulation, neat hocks. Moved sound and steady. BPIS

- 1 WEYMAN'S SPUFFING RIOJA Elegant young lady with nice proportions. Pleasing feminine head, nice neck and good shoulders. Neatly set elbows. Good depth through chest and loin. Good angulation, tight feet and moved well.

- 1 GREEN'S KENNAIR LIKE A DIAMOND Third in strong junior class, Lots to like in this B/W. She has nice proportions, pleasing head, good neck and shoulders, good depth of chest, firm topline, good through loin and hindquarters. Moves o.k.

GB (4, 2 ABS)

- 1 COKELL'S CARLYQUINN CANDY KISSES Lovely young bitch with well balanced outline. Really nice feminine head with good definition, eye colour could be

a little darker. Lovely front with good bone and feet. Nice angulation and moves well. Just needs to mature, then, hopefully she should follow in her parents footsteps.

2 McGOVERN'S RISELAWROAD COPACABANA FOR BAXLABACH Liked her head and neck line. Good shoulder angulation. Neat elbows. Good body and loin. Slightly long cast

PGB (8, 4 ABS)

1 SAVELL'S PETRANELLA GOSSIP GIRL JW Lovely head, so well balanced with kind expression. Good construction throughout with substance but totally feminine. Pleasing through neck and shoulders, lovely front with good bone. Good body with nice rib and strength of loin. Sound on the move.

2 TAUBMAN'S PEASBLOSSOM GEISHA AT MEONSTOKE I just loved her head which reflects a lovely kind expression. Feminine throughout with lovely lines. Really good neck and shoulders. Good front and tight elbows. Lovely body and excellent on the move.

Nice reach of neck flowing into shoulders and an excellent topline. Good front and rear angulation. Plenty of width through hindquarters. Good bone and feet. Coming into her prime and am sure will go all the way. RCC

2 CALVERT'S CALVDALE HEARSAY JW Very elegant with head to match. Good reach of neck flowing into good shoulders. Good body, rib with strong loin. Nice bone and feet. Just lost her topline at times and a little untidy on the move.

OB (4, 1 ABS)

1 COKELL'S SH CH CARLYQUINN CLASSIC LINE JW Another that needs to be handled to be appreciated. Can look a little ordinary from the ringside but I thought she was a lovely puppy last time I judged her and now she has matured into a beautiful adult. Her eye has darkened to finish a lovely head and expression. Nice arch in neck and clean throat. Correct shoulder construction with neat elbow set. Good rib and loin. Nice width of hindquarters. Beautiful angulation and outline. Not overloaded with coat but her other virtues far outweigh this. Moves steady and true. CC

2 MITCHELL'S SU(U)CH ART-WAVES AWESOME Lots to like including a feminine head and kind expression. Good forechest, rib and loin. Good shoulder placement and nice bone. A little overdone in angulation and reach of neck. Not very settled on the move.

3 WALKER'S DEXBENELLA INQUISITRESS JW

1 WILSON & WHITLEY'S SHIPDEN YSATIS FOR DENESSHIP - Moved around the ring like a youngster. Good outline with level topline. Pleasing head.
