Minor Puppy Dog (4, 2a)

1. Corbett's Trimere Total Chaos

8 month liver/white puppy who stands out for his excellent type and balance, pleasing head, proportionate, dark eyes of pleasing shape, kind expression. Neck of correct length flowing to well placed shoulders, prominent forechest, ample bone, strong pasterns and good feet. Carrying correct amount of weight, strong body, pleasing hindquarters, when settled moved very positively.

2. Henson's Loxbourne Dreamboat

Puppy Dog (2,1a)

1. Corbett's Trimere Tidal Wave

11month tri, broader in head and a shade lighter in eye than I would have wanted, good length of neck and shoulders, straight forelegs, plenty of bone and round well padded feet. Body developing well, fell away over the croup and was very unsettled on the move. Shown in excellent condition.

Junior Dog (3,1a)

1. Brady's Kingsheath Zach Ryder

B/W 13 months of age and really looking the part. Not the biggest of dogs but well balanced and nicely made. Masculine head without coarseness, well set shoulders with good bone and feet, well bodied and moderate turn of stifle, moved with panache and style.

2. Cumming's Tiverstone Thomas Rivers

Special Yearling Dog (4,1a)

1. Whittock's Kingsheath William Regal

Liver tri dog who stood out here today, beautiful head, fairly broad, flat cheeks, expressive eyes and a kind expression. Strong muscular neck leading into well placed shoulders, well boned legs and tight compact feet. Deep through the chest and well bodied, being critical would have preferred slightly less rear angulation, however hocks were well let down and shown in excellent muscletone. Excellent free mover, covering the ground with ease. Presented well with an abundance of coat.

1. Barnett's Glenbrows Had To Be

L/W alone but worthy of his place. Kind expression but I would have preferred a slightly longer and deeper muzzle, clean through the neck, just enough bone, would have preferred a better layback of shoulder, shown in good body, pleasing rear angles, very excitable on the move and certainly enjoying himself.

Post Graduate Dog (2, 2a)

Limit Dog (6, 2a)

1. Dunsdon & Woodbridge's Seaspring Shipwrecked JW

L/W with a pleasing head shape, proportionate, dark almond shaped eyes, masculine expression. Superb front assembly, straight forelegs, plenty of bone, feet could have been a little tighter. Deep chested, shown and presented in good condition, moved well maintaining his topline on the move. Reserve Best Dog.

Veteran Dog (1)

1. Young's Shelcasrie Flash ShCM

10 year old l/w dog, undoubtedly masculine without coarseness, pleasing head shape and kind expression. Moderate front angulation, well boned forelegs with well rounded, compact feet, shown in excellent body tone and condition, well sprung ribs, still holding a level topline. Moved ok.

Special Beginner Dog (2,1a)

1. Barnett's Glenbrows Had To Be

Minor Puppy Bitch (2, 1a)

1. Nicholson's Loxbourne Disco Diva at Kingsheath

6 month old and a real baby, l/w of super type, loved her head shape, kind dark expressive eyes, so typical in expression. Enough front angulation, strong neck, well off for bone and compact feet. Carrying enough weight, level topline, excellent rear, short hocks well let down, moved out well once settled. Completely blew her chances in the challenge for BPIS when she decided she'd rather enjoy herself. BPB

Puppy Bitch (3, 1a)

1. Corbett's Trimere Ta Dah

Feminine bitch who pleasing in outline for her age. Lovely head, dark eyes of almond shape, broad but retaining femininity. Strong through the neck and shoulders, body with enough depth, developing well, excellent topline standing and moving, well angulated rear and very sound on the move. Presented in excellent coat and condition.

2. Hughes's Celgarn Magalena with Melkami

Junior Bitch (3,2a)

1. Shovel's Tiverstone Bess Pool

L/W bitch of pleasing type and quality, just into junior and hitting the adolescent stage, I liked her head for shape and kind expression, dark eyes. Enough bone and good feet, moderately angulated front assembly. Well bodied, falls away over the croup and consequently tail a little low set. Pleasing rear angulation, moved very well, with freedom.

Yearling Bitch (4,1a)

1. Woodbridge's Crackerjanne Call Me Maybe

B/W bitch with a lovely head type, skull of good length, well chiselled below the eyes, dark almond shaped eyes and so feminine in expression. Really excellent in bone and feet, pleasing front assembly, correct shoulder, body of good depth and elbows close to body. Too long in body, but it is of good depth, moved very well in both directions.

Novice Bitch (1)

1. Woodbridge's Crackerjanne Call Me Maybe

Graduate Bitch (5,2a)

1. Williams & Toublic's Cobhay Dahlia

L/w bitch who lacks muzzle and who could have darker eyes which does detract from her expression. Well boned legs, standing on well-rounded feet, good body condition, well angulated rear and shown in hard muscletone.

Post Graduate Bitch (2)

1. Corbett's Trimere Teresa Green

Tri of super type and construction, so well balanced and typical in outline. Strong well moulded head but undoubtedly feminine, pleasing expression. Excellent front assembly, good bone and feet. Stands on good legs, enough depth of body, well ribbed, compact loin, maintains her topine standing and moving. Pleasing rear angulation, hocks well let down and stifles well turned, she comes into her own when moving, perfectly true fore and aft and moving out with freedom in profile. Still young but could not be denied here, BIS.

2. Shovel's Tiverstone Royal Snow

Limit Bitch (2)

1. Reynold's Mompesson Royal Flush

L/W who is beautifully headed, dark almond shaped eyes with such a kind expression. Neck of good length, pleasing shoulder placement, well boned legs with strong well rounded feet. Body of pleasing depth, good ribbing, strong rear, good depth of second thigh, short hocks and moved out on a positive stride. Liked her a lot, RBB.

2. Taubman's Peasblossom Geisha at Meonstoke

Open Bitch (4, 2a)

1. Corbett's Trimere Tough Cookie

L/W with the positive free movement this kennel is well known for, personally I found her a little too much in head for me, broad in back skull and with a little too much flew, although kind in expression. Good length of neck leading in to well-placed shoulders, good bone, would prefer tighter feet, super body proportions, just need to finish a little in depth, well angulated rear, maintained her topline standing and on the move.

2. Holman's Artycreath Diamond Dee

Veteran Bitch (2)

1. Joyce's Shelcasrie Lovers Leap

7 year old bitch who belied her age and who was shown in excellent condition. Pleasing head properties, dark eyes and a kind expression, clean through the neck and shoulders, super front assembly, appealed for her correct body proportions, excellent rear showing positive hind action, moved out very well. Pleased to award her best veteran in show.
